



DANCERS EDGE SEASON 15 DRESS CODE

INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF ARE AT LIBERTY TO ASK DANCERS TO SIT OUT OF CLASS IF THEY ARE NOT DRESSED APPROPRIATELY.
Dress Code is for the safety of both our dancers and staff.

- Dancers Edge dress code for all dancers requires hair to be pulled back out of your face.
- Jeans are NOT acceptable for class unless requested by an instructor
- No jewelry (studs are acceptable)
- All coloured shoes are acceptable for class. However the instructor may request a specific color prior to being on stage.

Dance Leotards, tights and shoes (Ballet, Jazz, Pointe,etc) can be purchased at Dance Street in Saskatoon. Dancers Edge also has a buy/sell page on Facebook and some items can be found on there as well.

Ballet

MANDATORY LEOTARDS, TIGHTS AND BALLET SLIPPERS. Dance shorts, skirts or dresses are optional. Pink ballet slippers are required for stage/photos. A split sole leather ballet slipper is recommended for our ballet dancers **under the age of 10** and a split sole canvas ballet slipper for dancers over the age of 10. There are no specifics on colors/styles of tights and leotards for classes. Ballet buns are required for Ballet.

Jazz

MANDATORY LEOTARD, TIGHTS AND JAZZ SHOES.

Shorts are optional. Tan slip on jazz shoes (no laces) are required for stage/photos. Hair is to be pulled back in a ponytail or bun for class.



Tap

MANDATORY TAN TIE UP SHOES, EXERCISE

ATTIRE Capris, Skirt, leggings or dance shorts (NO BAGGY PANTS). Tan slip on shoes are required for level 1. Black Tie up tap shoes are required for Tap 5.

Hair is to be pulled back in a ponytail or bun for class.



Hip hop

Exercise Attire (Sweat pants are acceptable). Black Nike shoes with white soles are required for performances and photos.



Lyrical

Exercise Attire, dresses and free flowing tops are acceptable for lyrical. Students can choose to wear: Tan jazz shoes, nude toe underwear or bare feet
Instructor will decide on stage footwear based on the group and the piece.

Modern

Exercise attire and bare feet, half soles, or Apolla socks. Instructors will decide on stage footwear based on the group and the piece.

Pointe & Pre-Pointe

Follow the same attire as ballet.

If you are new to the Pointe Program, please do not purchase pointe shoes in the summer months. Your child's instructor will provide guidance when it comes time to purchase your first pointe shoes. **Please have your pointe shoes properly fitted at Dance Street.** Ouch pouches are allowed for pointe dancers if they choose.



Musical Theater

MANDATORY BEIGE JAZZ SHOES AND EXERCISE ATTIRE. Hair is to be pulled back for class.



Acrobatic Arts

Exercise attire and bare feet. No baggy shirts or pants. Leotards, shorts and stirrup tights are acceptable. Hair must be pulled back.

The DE Crew

MANDATORY LEOTARD, TIGHTS AND JAZZ SHOES.

Shorts are optional. Tan slip on jazz shoes (no laces) are required for stage/photos. Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail or bun for class.



Exam Classes

CDTA Jazz Exams

Black tank leotard, beige tights, beige jazz shoes. Hair pulled back into a neat bun. No shorts, skirts or long sleeve leotards.



RAD Exams

Black Leotard, ballet pink tights, canvas ballet slippers. Hair must be pulled back into a neat bun. Wrap skirts are permitted for the prep class.
